

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Villanova No. 4 lode mining claim was located by

on the 20th day of October, 1964, situated in the UNKNOWN Mining District, EUREKA County,

State of NEVADA, and about 7 1/2 MILES EAST of Three BAR Ranch on The Head of Meadow Canyon IT IS ADJACENT TO Villanova No. 1 on The West (The East Boundary of Villanova No. 4 is contiguous with The West Boundary of Villanova No. 1).

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 300 feet from the location monument in a NORTHERLY direction, and 1200 feet in a Southernly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a open cut on the Villanova No. 1 to the benefit of Villanova No. 4 located about 30 feet in a Northerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 15 feet wide, 20 feet long and 5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Villanova No. 4 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Villanova No. 4 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Villanova No. 4 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Juniper Post 5 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Villanova No. 4 Claim" There is also a Juniper Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since October-23, 1964
