**Certificate of Location of Lode Claim**

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that a Lode Mining Claim named the Moco #19

was located by R. L. Coppage

on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1964; that it is situated in  
Mineral Hill Mining District Eureka County,

State of Nevada, and about 650' N 8° W distant from Cave Spring  
Moco #19 is contiguous with Moco #15 on N, Moco #18 on E,  
Moco #21 on S, & Moco #20 on W.

as near as known from present developments;  
and that he claim(s) 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral bearing ledge, lode, vein  
or deposit extending 750 feet from the location monument in a

Northerly direction, and 750 feet  
in a Southerly direction, together with Three Hundred feet in width on  
each side of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a bull dozer cut

situated about 3 feet in a Westerly  
direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 12 feet wide  
20 feet long and 2 1/2 feet deep,

exposing the ledge, vein or mineral deposit. Total cost of said work was \$ 2500

This claim was monumented on the 20<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1964

The NE corner is marked by a 4"x4" Wood Post 4  
feet high, inscribed NE corner Moco #19 mining claim;  
the SE corner is marked by a 4"x4" Wood Post 4  
feet high, inscribed SE corner Moco #19 mining claim;  
the SW corner is marked by a 4"x4" Wood Post 4  
feet high, inscribed SW corner Moco #19 mining claim;  
the NW corner is marked by a 4"x4" Wood Post 4  
feet high, inscribed NW corner Moco #19 mining claim.

There is also a 4"x4" Wood Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has  
been done and the location completed January 21, 1965
