CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that he has located a mining claim in the Antelope Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the Benmark No. 2.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is S. 48° E.

The name of the locator Julian E. Simpson

The said claim was located on the 10th day of November, 1964.

A. D. 1964, and is described in respect to* From Corner No. 1 of Benmark No. 2. The SE corner of Section 36, T24N, R49E, Mt. Diablo Meridian, bears N 58° E about 4½ miles. Corner No. 1 of Benmark No. 2 is identical with corner No. 2 of Benmark No. 1, and corner No. 4 of Benmark No. 2 is identical with corner no. 3 of Benmark No. 1.

The locator claim 8 1500 feet in length on said lode, 950 feet running N 48° W from the center of the discovery monument and 550 feet running S. 48° E from the center of the discovery monument along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is Excavation work done at various points on Benmark No. 2 and Benmark No. 1 claims which are contiguous, such work aggregating in excess of \$ 200 cost for the two contiguous claims.

and the location† and description of each corner‡ with the markings thereon§ are as follows:

The North No. 1 corner is marked by a 4"X 4" Post 4½ feet high and is inscribed B2/1 corner of Benmark No. 2 mine. The East No. 2 corner is marked by a 4"X 4" Post 4½ feet high and is inscribed B2/2 corner of Benmark No. 2 mine. The South No. 3 corner is marked by a 4"X 4" Post 4½ feet high, inscribed B2/3 corner Benmark No. 2 mine; the West No. 4 corner is marked by a 4"X 4" Post 4½ feet high, inscribed B2/4 corner Benmark No. 2 mine. There is a 4" X 4" X 4½ Post at the center of each side lines marked at each corner of each lode. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since January 31, 1965.

‡ The statute uses the word "location" in connection with "corners." That is to say, the geographical place of the corners, to-wit: at White Gold or Soda Lake, near its head, etc.

§ Corner of each of the four corners, with the blazings, mounds, trees, etc.

Any record of location which does not contain all the requirements of the statute is void.
