Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Juniper No 2 Lode Mining Claim was located by Louis Rossi and Tony Rossi, whose post-office address appears below, on the 26th day of August, 19 59

The general course of said lode or vein is Northerly and Southerly

The claim is situated in the Cortez Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and is about 4,500 feet S 55° E of Arctic adit, Cortez mine.

The locator claim 50 feet in a northerly direction and 1450 feet in a southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows: Open cut 4 ft wide, 6 ft high, 10 ft long, and 4 ft deep, completed by the Rossis as their original discovery work.

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the SE corner, a monument marked SE Cor Juniper No 2, thence in a westerly direction 600 feet to the SW corner, a monument marked SW Cor Juniper No 2, thence 750 feet in a northerly direction to the WS Center; a monument marked WSC Juniper No 2, thence 750 feet in an northerly direction to the NW corner, a monument marked NW Cor Juniper No 2, thence 600 feet in a easterly direction to the NE corner, a monument marked NE Cor Juniper No 2, thence 750 feet in a southerly direction to the ES Center, a monument marked ESC Juniper No 2, thence 750 feet southerly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is 4" X 4" post 4 1/2' long
