THIS INDENTURE, made the 25th day of September, A. D., 1964, by and between LEO J. PUCCINELLI, as Trustee, of the City of Elko, County of Elko, State of Nevada, party of the First Part, and ZARILLA P. COTTOM, of the Town of Carlin, County of Elko, State of Nevada, party of the Second Part,-

W I T N E S S E I H:

That the party of the First Part, for and in consideration of the sum of TEN AND NO/100 (\$10.00) DOLLARS, current lawful money of the United States of America, to him in hand paid by the party of the Second Part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, does by these presents grant, bargain, sell, convey, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the Second Part, and to her heirs and assigns forever all his right, title interest and estate, both at law and in equity, of the party of the First Part, in and to those certain unpatented lode mining claims situate, lying and being in the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and more particularly described as follows, to-wit:


