AMENDED & ADDITIONAL**CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION**

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certif. IES that he has located a mining claim in the unknown Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the BENMARK NO. 2

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is about S 50° E.

The name of the locator Julian E. Simpson, whose address is Box 305, Corte Madera, California.

The said claim was located on the 10th day of November,

A. D. 1964, and is described in respect to\* From corner no. 1 of Benmark No. 2, the SE corner of Section 23, T22N, R30E, Mt. Diablo Meridian, bears about S 41° E, approximately 12,900 feet, Corner no. 2 of Benmark No. 2 is identical with corner no. 1 of Benmark No. 3.

Original location certificate for Benmark No. 2 is recorded in Book 6 of Official Records, page 451, Records of Eureka County, Nevada

The locator claims 1500 feet in length on said lode, 250 feet running about S 50° E from the center of the disc monument and 1250 feet running about N 50° W from the center of the disc monument along the coarse of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is: an open cut and excavation along the lode, the size of which exceeds 8 feet by 12 feet by 15 feet, located at the discovery monument, and excavation work done at various points on Benmark No. 2 and Benmark No. 1 claims which are contiguous, such work aggregating in excess of \$ 200 cost for the two contiguous claims.

The northwest No. 1 corner is marked by a 4" X 4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet high and is inscribed B2/1X corner of Benmark No. 2 mine:

the northeast No. 2 corner is marked by a 4" X 4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet high

B2/2X inscribed B2/2X corner of Benmark No. 2 mine.

The southeast no. 3 corner is marked by 4"X 4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet high,

inscribed B2/3X corner Benmark 2 mine: the southwest no. 4 corner

is marked by a 4"X 4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  feet high, inscribed B2/4X corner

Benmark No. 2 mine. There is a 4"X 4" X 4 $\frac{1}{2}$  foot post at the center of each side line marked NSG & SSC

This certificate is in addition to that certain certificate locating the Benmark No. 2 claim dated February 2, 1965 and filed in the office of the County Recorder of Eureka Co. on Feb. 4, 1965
