

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

Revised Laws, Sec. 2424

The Undersigned, hereby certifies that he has located a mining claim in the unknown Mining District, County of Eureka, State of Nevada, on a vein or lode known as the BENMARK NO. 9.

The general course of said lode or vein, as near as it may be described, is S. 50° E.

The name of the locator Julian E. Simpson, whose address is Box 305, Corte Madera, California

The said claim was located on the 11th day of April 1965 A.D. 1965, and is described in respect to* From corner no. 1 of Benmark No. 9 the SE corner of Section 23, T22N, R50E, Mt. Diablo Meridian, bearing about S 40 E., approximately 14,500 feet. Corner No. 3 of Benmark No. 9 is identical with corner no. 4 of Benmark No. 10, corner no. 2 of Benmark No. 1 and corner no. 1 of Benmark No. 2.

The locator claim S 1500 feet in length on said lode, 365 feet running about S 50° E from the center of the discovery monument and 1135 feet running about N 50° W from the center of the discovery monument along the course of said vein or lode each way from the point of discovery with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and location of the discovery shaft work is An open cut and excavation along the lode, the size of which exceeds 5 feet by 12 feet by 20 feet, located at the discovery monument, and excavation work done at various points on Benmark No. 9 and Benmark No. 10 claims which are contiguous, such work aggregating in excess of \$ 200 cost for the two contiguous claims.

and the location† and description of each corner|| with the markings thereon§ are as follows:

The northwest no. 1 corner is marked by a 4"x4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high and is inscribed B9/1X corner of Benmark No. 9 mine: the northeast no. 2 corner is marked by a 7" dia. pinon post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high and is inscribed B9/2X corner of Benmark No. 9 mine.

The southeast no. 3 corner is marked by 4"x4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high, inscribed B9/3X corner Benmark 9 mine: the southwest no. 4 corner is marked by a 4"x 4" redwood post 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ feet high, inscribed B9/4X corner Benmark No. 9 mine.

There is a 4"x 4"x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " redwood post marked NSC and SSC at the center of each side line respectively. The discovery work has been done and the location work completed since April 16, 1965.
