KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that I the undersigned, do  
depose and say:

That at lease One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) worth of labor and  
improvements was performed or made during the assessment year ending at  
Noon on September 1, 1965 on the following named lode and placer claims  
situated in the Lynn Creek Mining District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, except for the Extension Nos. 1 thru 18, which are partly located  
in Elko County, Nevada:

Extension Nos. 1 thru 18, Look Out, Look Out Fraction,  
Ruth, Poor Man, Gold Strike Nos. 1 thru 36, Gold Bug  
Nos 1 thru 27, Triangular Fractions Nos. 1 and 2, Open  
Fraction, Gladys, Sidney, Sun Nos. 1 thru 9, Sheep Creek  
Nos. 1 and 2, and West Side Nos. 1 and 2.

That such work or improvements consisted of bulldozing, trench-  
ing and roadwork, including labor, materials and supplies, as well as  
(pursuant to the Act of September 2, 1958, 72 Stat. 1701) geological  
work of reconnaissance and detailed nature for mapping and identification  
of outcrops on all claims and including specific drilling at locations  
stated below, to verify faults, folds, etc. as to all claims, with drill  
holes located on Extension No. 8: 310' North of South line and  
325' East of West line.  
Extension No. 9: 310' North of South line and  
525' East of West line  
Gold Strike No. 5: 200' North of South line and  
250' West of East line  
Gold Strike No. 6: 135' North of South line and  
300' East of West line  
Sheep Creek No. 1: 250' North of South line and  
400' West of East line  
Poor Man Claim: 303' from Northwest claim corner  
on an azimuth North 61 West.

Work was performed by consulting geologists and mining engineers Victor W.  
Sweet, Dorsey Hager, and de Benniville K. Seeley, Jr., with basic findings  
that the geological work together with other drilling and sampling have  
proven that faults and veins that carry probable ore bodies are found on

the claims, but additional work is necessary to fix the extent and size of the ore bodies.

And that such labor or improvements were made by or at the expense of Dorsey Hager, et al, lessees of said claims, for the purpose of holding said claims.
