

CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Santa Fe Fraction lode mining claim was located by

on the 3rd day of August, 1965, situated in the Buckhorn Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and ~~also~~ ^{XXXX} located in unsurveyed T. 27N. R. 49E. The northern boundary is common with the southern boundaries of the DPM and Red Ant patented Lode claims, U.S. Mineral Survey 4130 and the eastern boundary is common with the western boundary of the Sunday Fraction patented Lode claim U.S. Mineral Survey 4130.

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a northerly direction, and 750 feet in a southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a trench located about 200 feet in a easterly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 14 feet wide, 47 feet long and 6 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Santa Fe Fraction Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Santa Fe Fraction Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Santa Fe Fraction Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a 4" x 4" post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Santa Fe Fraction Claim." There is also a 4' rock cairn at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since August 3, 1965
