THIS IS TO CERTIFY that a mining claim Antje No. 19

on the 18th day of September, 1965, situate in unorganized  
District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada and about 2.9 miles southwesterly from Roberts  
Creek Mountain (elev. 10,133') and approximately in the NW quarter of Section 27,  
Township 23 North, Range 50 East (unsurveyed). This claim is bounded on the NW  
by Antje #10, on the NE by Antje #1, on the SE by Antje #18, on the SW by  
Annie #4.

~~W&K~~ (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing  
ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument  
in a southeasterly direction, and 750 feet in a  
northwesterly direction, together with 300 feet on  
each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a bulldozed pit  
located about 25 feet in a N63°W direction from the location  
monument, and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 35 feet long  
and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post four feet high, inscribed "NW  
Corner of the Antje #19 Claim;" the southwest corner is marked by a  
post four feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Antje #19  
Claim;" the southeast corner is marked by a post four feet high, inscribed  
"SE Corner of the Antje #19 Claim;" the northeast corner is marked by a  
post four feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Antje #19  
Claim." There is also a post 4' high at the center of each side line. The discovery  
work has been done, and the location completed since October 22, 1965.
