### SETTLEMENT OF FIRST AND FINAL ACCOUNT AND DECREE OF DISTRIBUTION

ANGELA EVANS, as Administratrix, having on the 5th day of August, A. D. 1965, filed in this Court her First and Final Account and Petition for Distribution; said matter coming on regularly to be heard on the 16th day of August, 1965, notice of hearing of said Petitions having been given in the manner provided by law, and at said time and place said Administratrix appearing in person and being represented by her Attorney Gregory J. Chachas, Esq., and the Court hearing evidence adduced on behalf of said Account and Petition for Distribution, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that due and legal notice of the hearing of First and Final Account and Petition for Distribution was given in the manner and form as required by law, and that the residue of said estate, consisting of the property hereinafter described, is now ready for distribution, and said estate is now ready to be closed.

That the said JOE MARTIN, died intestate on or about the 22nd day of January, 1959, in the City of Reno, County of Washoe, State of Nevada, being at the time of his death and for some years prior thereto, a resident

 of the County of Eureka, State of Nevada, and that decedent left estate therein consisting of real and personal property.

That ANGELA EVANS, was appointed and qualified as Administratrix herein on the 1st day of April, 1965, and Letters of Administration duly issued to her on the 1st day of April, 1965.

That due Notice To Creditors was given as required by law, and that Creditors' Claims in the sums of Ninety-six (\$96.00) Dollars, Thirty and 60/100 (\$30.60) Dollars, and Sixteen and 50/100 (\$16.50) Dollars, have been filed herein.

That MR. and MRSEWILLIAM NEMYIER have paid delinquent taxes due and payable to date; current 1964 - 1965 taxes; and costs of administration. Mr. and Mrs. William Nemyler are to be refunded or reimbursed said sums for the delinquent taxes, current taxes, and costs of administration by CHARLES MARTIN from his share, when sale of said property is made.

That EDWIN C. MARTIN, the surviving son of the above-named decedent, is the sole and only person entitled to the assets of said estate.

That ANGELA EVANS, as Administratrix, has received no compensation whatsoever for or on account of said services rendered, and to be rendered, and should be allowed a reasonable fee therefor.

That GREGORY J. CHACHAS, ESQ., has rendered legal services to Petitioner herein and to the date hereof has received no compensation for his services rendered.

That CARLTON S. THOMAS, TOM PASTORINO and JOAN SHANGLE, the Court appointed Appraisers herein have rendered services to the estate herein and to the date hereof have received no compensation for such

services; and good cause appearing therefor;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the said First and Final Account and Petition for Distribution is approved, allowed and settled.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that all Creditors' Claims be paid.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that Mr. and Mrs. William Nemyler be reimbursed by Charles Martin for sums paid out for delinquent taxes, current taxes, creditors' claims, and costs of administration; the following sums paid, to-wit: \$528.73, taxes and penalties; \$143, 10 creditors claims; and \$359, 00, costs of administration.

The hereinabove costs paid by Mr. and Mrs. William Nemyler are to be reimbursed before Charles Martin receives any monies for the sale of the property.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED. ADJUDGED AND DECREED that ANGELA EVANS, be paid One Hundred Fourteen and no/100 (\$114.00) Dollars, as and for her services rendered herein, as Administratrix.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED. ADJUDGED AND DECREED that GREGORY J. CHACHAS, ESQ., be paid Two Hundred Twenty-five and no/100 (\$225, 00) Dollars, as and for his services rendered herein.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that CARLITON S. THOMAS, TOM PASTORINO and JOAN SHANGLE, be paid the sum of Ten (\$10.00) Dollars, each, as and for their services rendered as Appraisers.
