

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Railroad Mining Claim was located by Louis Rossi

on the 1st day of November 1965, situated in Beowawe District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about One mile south of the town of Beowawe, and about one half mile in a easterly direction from the old cinnabar mine.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)  
claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a West direction, and 750 feet in a East direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of cut (Shaft, cut or tunnel) situated about 100 feet in a East direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 10 feet high, 12 feet long and 10 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4 feet post feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Railroad Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a 4 feet post feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Railroad Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4 feet post feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Railroad Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a 4 feet post feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Railroad Mine." There is also a post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

15th day in Nov 1965.
