WHEREAS, In pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, and legislation supplemental thereto, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of Survey and the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Blko, Revada, accompanied by other evidence whereby it appears that

has entered and paid for the Water Pipe lode mining claim,

besignated by the Surveyor General as Servey No. 4473, subrepoing a portion of Sections three and ten in Tournship twenty-six north of Enge fifty-we cant of the Enge Mable Meridian, is the Eineral Hill Maing Matrict, Eurela Gounty, Sevada,

and bounded, described, and platted as follows: Beginning: Bt Courses: Be 1, 2 limestons rook 8 x 16 x 26 inches, marked with (I) at exact courses point and EP-1-4473, with mound of Stone; from which the east quarter observed Section ten in Tomoship twenty-six north of Hange fifty-two east of the Mount Diable Meridian, bears south Sixty-six degrees twenty minutes six seconds east four thousand five hundred four and Seventy-sight-hundredths feet distant;

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining ises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said above named and to his heirs and assigns forever; subject, nevertheles he above-mentioned and to the following conditions and stipulations:

FIRST. That the premises here anted shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights, as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, cu and decisions of the courts. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way d by the authority of the United States. thereon for ditches or canals cons

SECOND. That In the abo of necessary legislation by Congress, the Legislature of Nevada may provide rules for working nining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.
