

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Damele #7
 _____ was located by
Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr., Ronald D. Damele, Stephen
Damele, and Jack O'Connor of the J.D. Ranch Carlin, Nevada.
 on the 28 day of January 1966., situated in
Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 6 miles south-west of the J.D. Ranch.

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
 mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1500 feet from the
 location monument in a westerly direction, and 0
 feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet
 on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a pit
 (Shaft, cut or tunnel)
 situated about 35 feet in a westerly direction from the location
 monument and its dimensions are 9 feet wide, _____ feet high,
11 feet long and 10 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Damele #7 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "S.W. corner Damele #7
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high,
 inscribed "S. E. corner Damele #7 Mine"; the northeast corner is
 marked by a wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Damele #7 Mine." There is also a post 4"x4"x4' at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
March 27 1966
