

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Rain-cap was located by Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr., Ronald D. Damele, Stephen Damele, and Jack O'Connor of J. D. Ranch Carlin, Nevada. on the 26 day of January 1966, situated in Unknown Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 6 miles south-west of the J.D. Ranch.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1500 feet from the location monument in a southerly direction, and 0 feet in a northerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a pit (Shaft, cut or tunnel) situated about 50 feet in a southerly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 15 feet wide, 0 feet high, 40 feet long and 5 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Rain-cap Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a Wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Rain-cap Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Rain-cap Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a wooden-post 4"x4"x4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Rain-cap Mine." There is also a post 4"x4"x4' at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since March 27 1966.
