 monument and its dimensions are 4 feet wide, _____ feet high,
10 feet long and 8 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

Wooden-post

The northwest corner is marked by a 4" x 4" x 4" feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Sunday Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
4" x 4" x 4" feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Sunday
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Wooden-post 4" x 4" x 4" feet high,
 inscribed "S. E. corner Sunday Mine"; the northeast corner is
 marked by a Wooden-post 4" x 4" x 4" feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Sunday Mine". There is also a Post 4" x 4" x 4" at
 the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
21 day of March 1966
