

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Quartz #3 lode mining claim was located by (print names of locators & post office addresses) Leo J. Damele Eureka, Nevada on the 1st day of April, 1966, situated in the Udachinsk Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 4 miles south of Willow Creek Ranch, Center of claim is on ridge between Willow Creek and Birch Creek Canyons

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750 feet in a southerly together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a Open Cut located about 15 feet in a Westerly direction from the location monument, and dimensions are 2 feet wide, 3 feet long and 12 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by Post #4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Quartz #3 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Quartz #3 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high inscribed "SE Corner of the Quartz #3 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Quartz #3 Claim". There is also a Post #4 at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since April 1st, 1966.

on the 28th day of March, 1966, situated in the Herkeween Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 1 1/2 miles SW of Dry Creek cabin and about 4 miles West of Willow Creek Ranch on the summit between Willow and Dry Creek Canyons

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750 feet in a southerly direction, together with 350 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of an Open Cut located about 400 feet in a NW direction from the location monument, and dimensions are 5 feet wide, 35 feet long and 1 1/2 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Quartz #46 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Quartz #46 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high inscribed "SE Corner of the Quartz #46 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post #4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Quartz #46 Claim". There is also a Post #4 at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since March 28th, 1966.
