

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Tonkin #17 lode mining claim was located by (print names of locators & post office addresses)

on the 15th day of April, 1966, situated in the Hakroon Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 3 1/2 miles west of Tonkin Ranch

We claim 500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northwesterly direction, and 750 feet in a southeasterly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of an Open Cut located about 550 feet in a northeasterly direction from the location monument, and dimensions are 7 feet wide, 12 feet long, and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Tonkin #17 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Tonkin #17 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high inscribed "SE Corner of the Tonkin #17 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Tonkin #17 Claim". There is also a Post 4 at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since April 15th, 1966.
