

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

Cor., thence in a Westerly direction 750 feet to the South side center corner, a monument marked SSC Cor., thence 750 feet in a Westerly direction to the Southwest Corner corner, a monument marked SWC SC, thence 600 feet in a Northerly direction to the Northwest corner, a monument marked NWC Cor., thence 750 feet in a Easterly direction to the North side center corner, a monument marked NSC Cor., thence 750 feet in a Easterly direction to the Northeast corner, a monument marked N.E. SC, thence 600 feet Southerly to the point of beginning.
