

# Certificate of Location

The northwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Coal Canyon #4 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Coal Canyon # 4 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Coal Canyon # 4 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Coal Canyon # 4 Mine." There is also a Post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since October 21 1966.
