This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Coal Canyon #11 was located by

The discovery work consists of Drill Hole CC-3 Total Cost- \$2650

situated about 1500 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 3 feet wide, 3 feet high, 105 feet long and 105 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Coal Canyon #11 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S.W. corner Coal Canyon # 11 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Coal Canyon #11 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Coal Canyon # 11 Mine." There is also a Post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

October 21 19 66.
