

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Coal Canyon # 17 was located by Charles Damele, Sr., Charles Damele, Jr., Ronald Damele, Jack O'Connor

on the 19th day of October, 1966, situated in Unknown District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about West Side line of this claim is common with the East side line of Coal Canyon # 16

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Northerly direction, and 750 feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Drill Hole CC-7 Total Cost - \$2650 (Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 2800 feet in a Northwesterly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 185 feet wide, 185 feet high, 185 feet long and 185 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Coal Canyon # 17 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Coal Canyon # 17 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Coal Canyon # 17 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Coal Canyon # 17 Mine." There is also a Post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since Oct. 21 19 66.
