

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Hotsulph #4

was located by Howard E. Harris on 1110 Harmony Rd.
Winnemucca, Nevada.

on the 15 day of October 1966, situated in
Beowawe District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about 4 Miles S.E. of Crescent Valley,
Store, on Hotspring Point. Located in
Sec's 11 & 12, T29 N R48 E. The East
side line joins End lines of Hotsulph,
Hotsulph #5 & #6, and the Jack #1. claims.
The North End line is common to S. End line of Hotsulph #1

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

1500 claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 50 feet from the
location monument in a Northerly direction, and 1450
feet in a Southerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of An Open Cut

(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 10 feet in a Easterly direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are 12 feet wide, 4 feet high,
20 feet long and 6 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Hotsulph #4 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
Post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Hotsulph #4
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a Post 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Hotsulph #4 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Hotsulph #4 Mine." There is also a Post Pile at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
October 15 1966.
