inscribed "S. E. corner Hotsulph # 5 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a Post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Hotsulph # 5 Mine." There is also a Rock pile at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
