

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Indian Ranch # 4
was located by
Leo J. Damele and John V. Damele, both of Eureka, Nevada

on the Eighth day of October 19 66, situated in
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 3 1/2 miles in a westerly direction from Tonkin Ranch
and 1/2 mile southwest from the Stony Creek Water Cross Spring.

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the
location monument in a southwesterly direction, and 750
feet in a northeasterly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of \$100 development work including a rotary drill
hole (Shaft, cut or tunnel)
situated about 1000 feet in a northerly direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are feet wide, feet high,
 feet long and 200 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Indian Ranch # 4 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Indian Ranch # 4
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Indian Ranch # 4 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Indian Ranch # 4 Mine." There is also a post at
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
