

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Indian Ranch # 7  
was located by  
Leo J. Damele and John Damele, both of Eureka, Nevada

on the Eleventh day of October 1966, situated in  
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, and about 3 miles northwest of Tonkin Ranch and approximately  
1 mile south of Stony Field Water Cross Spring

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the  
location monument in a northeasterly direction, and 750  
feet in a southwesterly direction, together with 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of \$100 development work including a rotary drillhole  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 2500 feet in a northerly direction from the location  
monument and its dimensions are \_\_\_\_\_ feet wide, \_\_\_\_\_ feet high,  
\_\_\_\_\_ feet long and 200 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner Indian Ranch #7 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Indian Ranch #7  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner Indian Ranch #7 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
Indian Ranch #7 Mine." There is also a post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
