

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Indian Ranch No. 8 was located by Leo J. Damele and John V. Damele, both of Eureka, Nevada

on the Eleventh day of October 1966, situated in Unknown District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 2½ miles northwest from Tonkin Ranch and approximately halfway between Indian ranch and rooster Canyon

Sec. 21, T. 24 N., R. 49 E.

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a Westerly direction, and 750 feet in a northeasterly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of \$100 development work including a rotary drill hole (Shaft, cut or tunnel) situated about 3000 feet in a northerly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 200 feet wide, 200 feet high, 200 feet long and 200 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Indian Ranch No. 8 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Indian Ranch No. 8 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Indian Ranch No. 8 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Indian Ranch No. 8 Mine." There is also a post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since December 22 1966
