

# Certificate of Location

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Jack-S. No. 2 lode mining claim was located by Jack A. Esposito & Howard E. Harris on the 25<sup>th</sup> day of November, 1967.

The general course of said lode or vein is Northerly & Southerly.

The claim is situated in the Beowawe Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, in Sect. 12, T. 29 N., R. 48 E. M.D.M. on Hot Spring Point.

A Rock Pile marks the center of each side line.
