

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the RED HILL No. 15

was located by
Leo J. Damele and John V. Damele, both of Eureka, Nevada

on the 19th day of January 1967, situated in
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 3 miles S.W. of Roberts Mountain in Red Hill Canyon,
Unsurveyed Township 23 North, Range 50 East. West Side Line Red
Hill No. 15 same as East Side Line Red Hill No. 12.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)
WE claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 100 feet from the
location monument in a Southerly direction, and 1400
feet in a Northerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a cut
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)
situated about 50 feet in a Southerly direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 10 feet high,
10 feet long and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a 4X4 post 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Red Hill No. 15 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
4X4 post 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Red Hill No. 15
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a 4X4 post 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Red Hill No 15 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a 4X4 post 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Red Hill No. 15 Mine." There is also a 4X4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
