

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton (agent) has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source (well # 1) through drilled well, pipeline sprinkler system for irrigation purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW¹/₄ SW¹/₄ Sec. 28, T. 21N., R. 53E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point from which the S. W. corner of said Section 28, bears S. 45° 06' W., a distance of 1800.0 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:
