SECTION 16: W 1/2

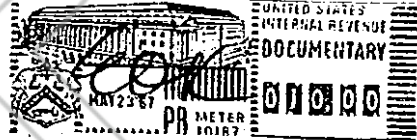
EXCEPTING THEREFROM, all the oil and gas as re-

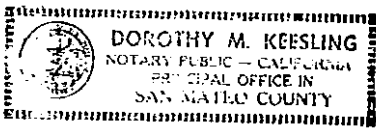
