

Certificate of Location of Lode Mining Claim

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the B. #6 Lode Mining Claim was located by Jack Esposito & B. Thompson whose post office address appears below, on the 26 day of May, 1967.

The general course of said lode or vein is Northerly & Southerly

The claim is situated in the Barro Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, Sec 13-T29N-R48E

East side of road to Newegdan ranch

The locator's claim 1450 feet in a Westerly direction and 50 feet in a Easterly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows:

8' x 6' trench 12 ft wide 600 ft long 1 ft deep

The total cost of such work consisted of at least \$ 11.00 11.00

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:

From the North East corner, a monument marked JB NE Cor., thence in a Southerly direction 600 feet to the South East corner, a monument marked JB SE, Cor., thence 750 feet in a westerly direction to the South side center, a monument marked South SC, thence 750 feet in a westerly direction to the South West corner, a monument marked JB SW Cor., thence 600 feet in a Northerly direction to the North West corner, a monument marked JB NW, Cor., thence 750 feet in a Easterly direction to the North side center, a monument marked North SC, thence 750 feet Easterly to the point of beginning.

Each of the above-described monuments is post 4 1/2 ft x 4" x 4"

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by June 2, 1967.
