

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Mark Chilton - Agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 (Lot 6) Section 24, T. 20N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the SE corner of said Sec. 24 bears S. 63° 28' E., 1183.0 feet. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 29, 1957

Description of land to which the water is appurtenant: 13.1 acres in the Tract 37 Section 24, T. 20N., R. 53E., M.D.B. & M.

This certificate is issued subject to the terms of the permit.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place and for the purpose as set forth herein.
