

# Certificate of Location

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Hotsulph No. 11 lode mining claim was located by Howard E. Harris on the 10<sup>th</sup> day of June, 1967.

The general course of said lode or vein is Northwesterly & Southerly.

The claim is situated in the Browns Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, 1/4 Mi. S.W. of Hotspring Point, Sec. 11, T29N, R49E, N. End line common w/ S. End of Hotsulph No. 8 E. Side common w/ Hotsulph No. 9 W. Side.  
The locator... claim S. 50 feet in a (N) Northwesterly direction and 14.50 feet in a (S) Southerly direction from the point of discovery, with a width of 300 feet on each side of the center of the vein or lode along the entire length of said claim.

The dimensions and locations of the discovery work done on the claim are as follows:  
An open cut 12' x 6' x 8' located near the discovery monument.

The corners and side centers of the claim are located and marked as follows:  
North West Cor. is marked by a post 4 1/2' high inscribed "N.W. Cor. Hotsulph No.11". The Southwest Cor. is a post 4 1/2' high marked "S.W. Cor. Hotsulph No.11". The Southeast cor. is a post 4 1/2' high marked "S.E. Cor. Hotsulph No.11". The Northeast Cor. is a post 4 1/2' high marked "N.E. Cor. Hotsulph No.11." The center of each side line is marked by a post 4 1/2' high.

Each of the above-described monuments is as described above.

All location and discovery work necessary to complete this location had been performed by July 1, 1967.
