State of Nevada, and about 1/2 mile south of Mine Well & 1 1/2 miles SW of Wood Camp Park on Easterly edge of Antelope Valley. This claim is parallel to & over laps some of Antelope North, a patented claim.

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1200 feet from the location monument in a N.E. direction, and 300 feet in a SW direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a trench, core, arch & etc with a drift located about 1000 feet in a Westerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 10 feet long and 10 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Apex #5 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Apex #5 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Apex #5 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Apex #5 Claim." There is also a 4' post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since 1 July, 1967

on the 1st day of June, 1967, situated in the Eureka Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 1/2 mile south of Mine Well & 1 1/2 miles SW of Wood Cone Peak on Westerly edge of Antelope Valley. This claim is parallel to & overlaps some of Antelope South, a patented claim, to the North.

We (or I) claim 1200 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1400 feet from the location monument in a S.W. direction, and 100 feet in a N.E. direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a trach. cone, overburden with drift located about 800 feet in a Westerly direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 6 feet wide, 11 feet long and 50 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Apex #6 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Apex #6 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Apex #6 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4' feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Apex #6 Claim." There is also a 4 post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since 1 July, 1967.
