

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Dry #9

was located by Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr., & Ronald Damele

on the 27<sup>th</sup> day of July 1967, situated in Unknown District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 2 1/2 miles southeasterly of Willow Cr. Ranch

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1450 feet from the location monument in a westerly direction, and 50 feet in a easterly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of 2 rotary drill holes (Shaft, cut or tunnel) situated about 200 x 300 feet in a westerly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 80 x 135 feet wide, 80 x 135 feet high, feet long and 80 x 135 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Dry #9 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Dry #9 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Dry #9 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Dry #9 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since Oct 12 1967
