

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz # 17

was located by Leo J. Damele Eureka, Nevada

on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of August 1967, situated in Unknown District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 3 miles southerly from Willow Cr. Branch

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument):

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1490 feet from the location monument in a southerly direction, and 10 feet in a northerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a cut (Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 5 feet in a southeasterly direction from the location monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 40 feet long and 3 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Quartz # 17 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz # 17 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz # 17 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Quartz # 17 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4 post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
