

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz # 42 was located by

John V. Damele & Leo J. Damele
Eureka, Nevada

on the 14th day of August 1967, situated in
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about 1/2 mile from Dry Creek cabin &
is contiguous with Claims 43 & 44. The discovery
monument is about 150 ft. west of the Willow Cr.
Dry Cr. Canyon road.

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1450 feet from the
location monument in a northwesterly direction, and 50
feet in a southerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a cut
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)
situated about 75 feet in a southeast direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, feet high,
6 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Quartz # 42 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz # 42
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz # 42 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Quartz # 42 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
October 10 1967.
