

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz # 43

was located by John V. Damele & Leo J. Damele Eureka, Nevada

on the 14 day of August 1967, situated in Unknown District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about 1 mile southerly from Dry Creek Cabin
& about 150 feet west of Willow Cr & Dry Cr.
Canyon Road.

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of

monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, _____ feet high,
6 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz # 43

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz # 43 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Quartz # 43 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
