

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz # 44

was located by John V. Damele & Leo J. Damele

Eureka, Nevada

on the 14th day of August 1967, situated in

Unknown District, Eureka County, State of

Nevada, and about 1 mile in a southerly direction

from Dry Cr. Cabin, just west of Dry Cr

& Willow Cr. Canyon road. This claim is

contiguous with quartz # 45.

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of

mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1450 feet from the

location monument in a northerly direction, and 50

feet in a southerly direction, together with 300 feet

on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a cut

(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 30 feet in a northwest direction from the location

monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, feet high,

6 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed

"N. W. corner Quartz # 44 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a

post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz # 44

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high,

inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz # 44 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Quartz # 44 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
