

# Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Quartz # 45  
was located by  
John V. Damele & Leo J. Damele

on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August 1967, situated in  
Unknown District, Eureka County, State of  
Nevada, and about 1  $\frac{1}{4}$  miles in a southerly direction  
from Dry Cr. Cabin & just west of Willow Cr.,  
Dry Cr. roads

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of  
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1450 feet from the  
location monument in a southerly direction, and 50  
feet in a northerly direction, together with 300 feet  
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a cut  
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)  
situated about 60 feet in a southeast direction from the location  
monument and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 6 feet high,  
6 feet long and 4 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed  
"N. W. corner Quartz # 45 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a  
post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Quartz # 45  
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high,  
inscribed "S. E. corner Quartz # 45 Mine"; the northeast corner is  
marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner  
Quartz # 45 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4' post at  
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
