

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Dry # 14

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 1450 feet from the

location monument in a easterly direction, and 50

feet in a westerly direction, together with 300 feet

on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a drill hole
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)

situated about 295 feet in a Northerly direction from the location

monument and its dimensions are of Dry # 5 feet wide, feet high,

feet long and 185 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed

"N. W. corner 0 Dry # 14 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a

post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Dry # 14

Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high,

inscribed "S. E. corner Dry # 14 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4' feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Dry # 14 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4' post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since

October 12 1967.
