This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Dry # 15

inscribed "S. E. corner Dry # 15 Mine"; the northeast corner is

marked by a post 4" x 4" x 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner

Dry # 15 Mine." There is also a 4" x 4" x 4 post at

the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
