

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Dry #16 was located by

claim 1500 linear feet along the course of mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 14.50 feet from the location monument in a easterly direction, and 50 feet in a westerly direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of Boring Drill Hole (Shaft, cut or tunnel) situated about 295 feet in a northw^{1/2} direction from the location monument and its dimensions are of Dry #5 feet wide, feet high, feet long and 185 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. W. corner Dry #16 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Dry #16 Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "S. E. corner Dry #16 Mine"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4"x4"x4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner Dry #16 Mine." There is also a 4"x4"x4 post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
