To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of survey of *Section* of the *Northwestern Consolidated Mining Company* upon the *Western and Northwestern* lands.

accompanied by the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at *Butte*, in the State of *Montana*, whereby it appears that, in pursuance of the said Revised Statutes of the United States, the said

Northwestern Consolidated Mining Company

did, on the *fourteenth* day of *January*, A. D. 188*7*, make and pay for said mining claim or claims, being Mineral Entry No. 521, in the office of said Office, designated by the Surveyor General as Lot No. 26 embracing a portion of the unincorporated public domain

in the *Butte* Mining District in the County of *Butte* and State of *Montana*, in the District of Lands subject to sale at *Butte*, containing *nine and sixty four hundredths (96)* acres of land, more or less,

and, according to the returns on file in the General Land Office, bounded, described, and plotted as follows, with magnetic variation at *eighty (80) degrees, thirty (30) minutes* East to wit:

Begin at corner No. 1a Post marked "118" U. S. Survey No. 216 the same being (S 80° E of Lot No. 148, made for the Albion N. S. land from which Ruby Hill prominent Mt. West South forty (40) degrees forty (40) minutes East, at the distance of twenty five hundred and fifty (2500) feet, and the Western Corner being North

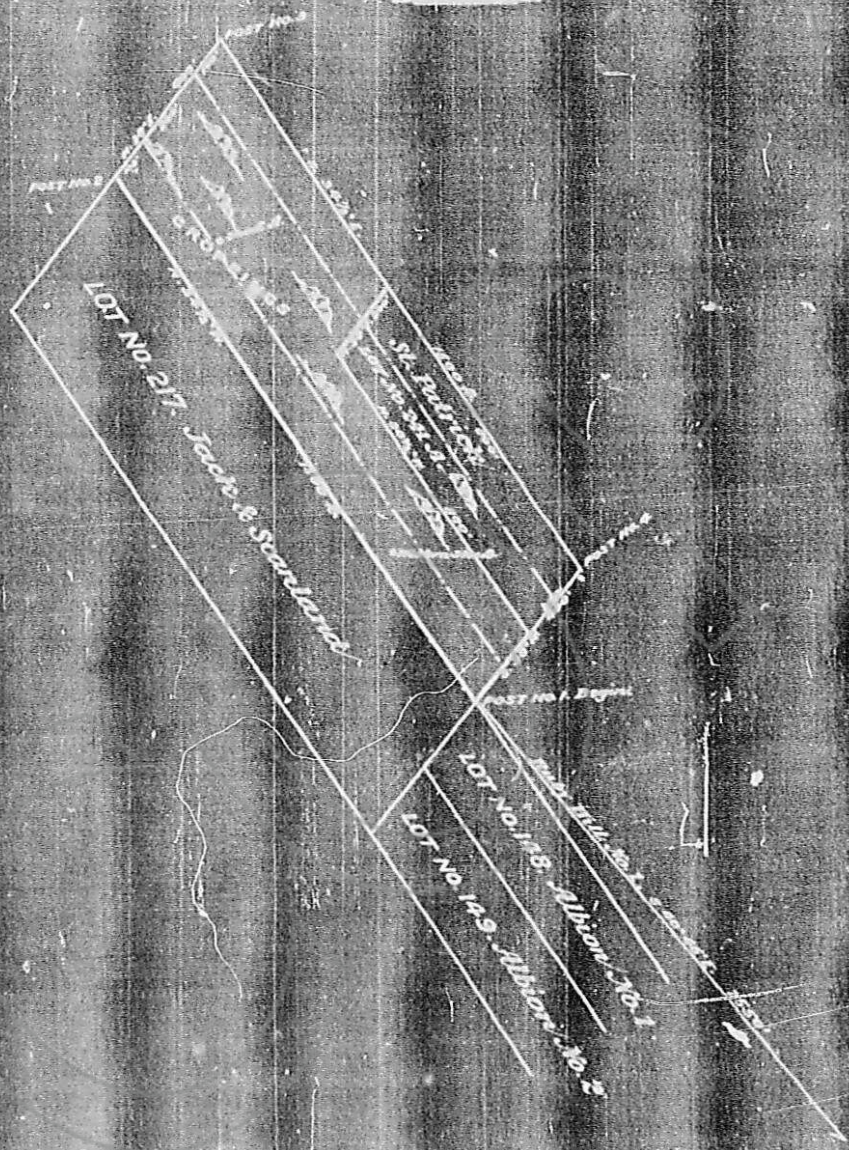

NOW KNOW YE, That the United States of America, in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the Revised Statutes of the United States, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the

Northwestern Consolidated Mining Company
and to *its successors*, all and singular the said mining premises hereinafter described as *lot 24 in the western 1/4 of section 35th and 36th public domain*

with the exclusive right of possession and enjoyment of all the land included within the exterior lines of said survey not herein expressly excepted from these presents, and of *fifteen hundred (1500)* linear feet of the said *Western and Nevada* vein, lode, ledge, or deposit for the length hereinafter described, throughout its entire depth, although it may enter the land adjoining, and also of all other veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits throughout their entire depth, the tops or apices of which lie inside the exterior lines of said survey at the surface extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical aide lines of said survey: *Provided*, That the right of possession hereby granted to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the end lines of said survey at the surface, as continued in their own direction that such vertical planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits, *excepting and excluding however from these presents all that portion of the above said vein and lode ledge or deposit which is embraced by said lot 24 in the*

And provided further, That nothing in this conveyance shall authorize the tenant, herein *mentioned*, or assigns, to enter upon the surface of a mining claim owned or possessed by another. To HAVE AND TO HOLD said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said

Northwestern Consolidated Mining Company

and to *its successors*, and assigns forever, subject, nevertheless, to the following conditions and stipulations:

First, That the grant hereby made is restricted to the land hereinbefore described as *lot 24 in the* with *fifteen hundred (1500)* linear feet of the *Western and Nevada* vein, lode, ledge, or deposit for the length aforesaid throughout its entire depth as aforesaid, together with all other veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits throughout their entire depths as aforesaid, the tops or apices of which lie inside the exterior lines of said survey.

Second, That the premises hereby conveyed, with the exception of the surface, may be entered by the proprietor of any other vein, lode, ledge, or deposit, the top or apex of which lies outside the exterior limits of said survey, should the same in its downward course be found to penetrate, intersect, extend into, or underlie the premises hereby granted, for the purpose of extracting and removing the ore from such other vein, lode, ledge, or deposit.

Third, That the premises hereby conveyed shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of courts.

Fourth, That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the legislature of *Nevada* may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I, *Charles A. Arthur* PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto affixed.
