To all to whom these presents shall come, Greeting:

WHEREAS, in pursuance of the provisions of the Revised Statutes of the United States, Chapter Six, Title Thirty-two, there have been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States the Plat and Field Notes of survey of the mining claim known as the North Western Consolidated Mining Company up to

Silver Bell and Ruby Hill, et cetera,

accompanied by the Certificate of the Register of the Land Office at Eureka, in the State of Nevada, whereby it appears that, in pursuance of the said Revised Statutes of the United States, the said



Beginning at Corner No. 1 a Post marked "No. 1 U.S. Survey No. 205" from which Ruby Hill to Bear South thirty three (33) degrees sixteen (16) minutes East at the distance of forty seven hundred and fifty six (4756) feet; Thence past said Corner No. 1 North fifty five (55) degrees thirty (30) minutes East, one hundred (100) feet to Corner No. 8, a Post marked "No. 2.

Foley with his claim upon the Badger Lode, from which corner No. 3 of said Lot No. 216 bears South fifty-one and one-half degrees (51.5) minutes West at the distance of forty and four tenths (40.4) feet fifteen hundred (1500) feet to Corner No. 3, a rock marked "No. 38 No. 255," thence South forty-five (45) degrees thirty (30) minutes East, four hundred (400) feet to Corner No. 4, a rock marked "No. 4. 

NOW KNOW YE, that the United States of America in consideration of the premises, and in conformity with the said Revised Statutes of the United States, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said

Hecla Mining Consolidated Mining Company,  
and to its successors, and assigns, the said mining premises hereinbefore  
described as Lot No. 257, in the State of Nevada, a portion of the unsurveyed  
public domain,

with the exclusive right of possession and enjoyment of all the land included within the exterior lines of said survey, not herein expressly excepted from these presents, and of silver, lead, zinc vein, lode, ledge, or deposit for the length hereinbefore described, throughout its entire depth, although it may enter the land adjoining, and also of all other veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits throughout their entire depth, the tops or apexes of which lie inside the exterior lines of said survey, if the surface be extended downward vertically, although such veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits in their downward course may so far depart from a perpendicular as to extend outside the vertical side lines of said survey. Provided, That the right of possession hereby granted to such outside parts of said veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits shall be confined to such portions thereof as lie between vertical planes drawn downward through the exterior lines of said survey at the surface, continued in their own direction that such vertical planes will intersect such exterior parts of said veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits.

Exclusivity and non-interference between these premises and other portions of the survey, subject, however, to the extent, which is sufficient to prevent conflict.

And provided further, That nothing in this conveyance shall authorize the grantee herein, to enter upon the surface of a mining claim owned or possessed by another to have and to hold said mining premises, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatever nature thereunto belonging, unto the said

Hecla Mining Consolidated Mining Company,

and to its successors, and assigns forever, subject, nevertheless, to the following conditions and stipulations:

*First.* That the grant hereby made is restricted to the land hereinbefore described as Lot No. 257, with silver, lead, zinc vein, lode, ledge, or deposit for the length aforesaid throughout its entire depth as aforesaid, together with all other veins, lodes, ledges, or deposits throughout their entire depths as aforesaid, the tops or apexes of which lie inside the exterior lines of said survey.

*Second.* That the premises hereby conveyed, with the exception of the surface, may be entered by the proprietor of any other vein, lode, ledge, or deposit, the top or apex of which lies outside the exterior limits of said survey, should the same in its downward course be found to penetrate, intersect, extend into, or underlie the premises hereby granted, for the purpose of extracting and removing the ore from such other vein, lode, ledge, or deposit.

*Third.* That the premises hereby conveyed shall be held subject to any vested and accrued water rights for mining, agricultural, manufacturing, or other purposes, and rights to ditches and reservoirs used in connection with such water rights as may be recognized and acknowledged by the local laws, customs, and decisions of courts.

*Fourth.* That in the absence of necessary legislation by Congress, the legislature of Nevada may provide rules for working the mining claim or premises hereby granted, involving easements, drainage, and other necessary means to its complete development.

IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF I, Chas A. Atchison, PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, have caused these letters to be made PATENT, and the SEAL OF THE GENERAL LAND OFFICE to be hereunto annexed.
