

Certificate of Location

This Is to Certify, That a mining claim named the Jackrabbit #34 was located by

Charles Damele Sr., Charles Damele Jr., Ronald Damele and
Jack O' Connor all of Eureka, Nevada.

on the 15 day of November 1967, situated in
Buckhorn Mining District, Eureka County, State of
Nevada, and about 5 miles west of the Buckhorn mine. Also
the north end line of this claim is common with the south end
line of Jackrabbit #32.

(Refer to some natural object or permanent monument)

We claim 1500 linear feet along the course of
mineral bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the
location monument in a northerly direction, and 750
feet in a southerly direction, together with 300 feet
on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of drill hole 400 feet in depth
(Shaft, cut or tunnel)
situated about 100 feet in a W easterly direction from the location
monument and its dimensions are --- feet wide, ---- feet high,
---- feet long and ---- feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post, 4 feet high, inscribed
"N. W. corner Jackrabbit #34 Mine"; the southwest corner is marked by a
post, 4 feet high, inscribed "S. W. corner Jackrabbit #34
Mine"; the southeast corner is marked by a post, 4 feet high,
inscribed "S. E. corner Jackrabbit #34 Mine"; the northeast corner is
marked by a post, 4 feet high, inscribed "N. E. corner
Jackrabbit #34 Mine." There is also a post at
the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done and the location completed since
November 30 1967.
