

## CERTIFICATE OF LOCATION

## LODE-QUARTZ

THIS IS TO CERTIFY that the Anna #4 lode mining claim was located by

David H. Bissett

on the 19 day of November, 1967, situated in the Eureka Mining District, Eureka County, State of Nevada, and about 750 feet NW of the Burning Moscow Mine. Adjoins north side of Anna #3 and south side of Anna #5, and east side of Anna #6

We (or I) claim 1500 linear feet along the course of the mineral-bearing ledge, lode or vein, extending 750 feet from the location monument in a east direction, and 750 feet in a west direction, together with 300 feet on each side of the center of the ledge for the entire length of the claim.

The discovery work consists of a legal sized excavation located about 50 feet in a east direction from the location monument, and its dimensions are 10 feet wide, 20 feet long and 6 feet deep, exposing ledge, lode or vein in place.

The northwest corner is marked by a post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "NW Corner of the Anna #4 Claim"; the southwest corner is marked by a post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "SW Corner of the Anna #4 Claim"; the southeast corner is marked by a post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "SE Corner of the Anna #4 Claim"; the northeast corner is marked by a post 4 1/2 feet high, inscribed "NE Corner of the Anna #4 Claim." There is also a post at the center of each side line. The discovery work has been done, and the location completed since Dec. 31, 1967
