CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. V. Caselli, agent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from an underground source through drilled well, pump and irrigation system for irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 7, T. 22N., R. 54E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point from which the E 1/4 corner of said Section 7 bears S. 78° 11' E., a distance of 1,893.37 feet, situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of NRS 533.425, has determined the date, source, purpose, amount of appropriation, and the place where such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 5.5 c.f.s., but not to exceed 1,280.0 ac. ft. per season
Period of use, from: May 1st to September 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: August 13, 1959
