Such labor and improvements so made consisted of not less than 1,660 feet of exploratory drilling on Black Hill No. 4 claim and 3,515 feet of exploratory drilling on Black Hill No. 7 claim and 4,730 feet of exploratory drilling on Black Hill No. 8 claim and 1,450 feet of exploratory drilling on Black Hill No. 9 claim and 1,655 feet of exploratory drilling on Black Hill No. 10 claim.

Such labor was performed and such improvements were made for the benefit of all of said claims as a part of a common plan of exploration and development and the same tend to improve and develop each of the above named mining claims for which this Affidavit of Proof of Labor is filed.
